### The ideal candidate:

You will need to be highly enthusiastic and self-motivated with proven web development experience. At least 4 years in a web development role is essential, agency-side experience is preferred. A degree or equivalent qualification in an appropriate field would be expected, but not essential.

Although this is not a design role, you will be working alongside designers and will need to use the Adobe Creative Suite to turn designs into high-quality, pixel-perfect, responsive websites with an extra transitional flair here and there. An eye for detail and a desire for the highest standards is essential. Experience with WordPress, E-Commerce platforms and CMS systems at a bespoke level would be a necessity for this role.

You will need to demonstrate a proactive attitude, the ability to manage your own time and projects and good communication skills, as some client contact work will be necessary.

This is a fantastic opportunity to become a member of a small web team. We are based just outside Exeter, so having your own transport will be essential for this role although some home-working is a possibility.
